1. After hearing both sides at some length, and when we expressed our disinclination to interfere with the interim order of the Tribunal dated 28th February, 2017 in VAT Second Appeal Nos. 84 to 86 of 2016, particularly, by keeping all questions open, Mr. Sridharan, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner, seeks eight weeks' additional time to comply with the Tribunal's order and direction.

2. In the peculiar facts and circumstances, when a sum of Rs.5,72,04,411/- has been deposited, the additional sum of

Rs.2,27,83,168/- be deposited within a period of eight weeks from today. If compliance is reported, then, the Tribunal to take up the appeals and decide the same in accordance with law. Failure to comply with the direction shall invite all consequences as permissible in law.

3. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above directions.
