**No. STA. 11.00/CR-151/Taxation-1.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by entry 37 in Schedule A appended to the Bombay Sales Tax Act, 1959 (Bom. LI of 1959), the Government of Maharashtra hereby, specifies the following Non-conventional Energy devices for the purpose of the said entry 37 with effect from 13th September 2000, namely:-

<b>1</b>	Flat plate solar collectors.
<b>2</b>	Concentrating and pipe type solar collectors.
<b>3</b>	Solar cookers.
<b>4</b>	Solar water heaters and systems.
<b>5</b>	Solar air heating systems.
<b>6</b>	Solar crop dryers and systems.
<b>7</b>	Solar stills and desalinations systems.
<b>8</b>	Solar pumps based on solar thermal and solar photovoltaic conversion.
<b>9</b>	Solar power generating systems.
<b>10</b>	Solar photovoltaic modules and panels, for water pumping and other applications.
<b>11</b>	Wind mills and any specially designed services which run on windmills.
<b>12</b>	Any special devices including electric generators and pumps running on wind energy.
<b>13</b>	Biogas plants and biogas engines (stove) and parts, components and accessories of biogas plants and biogas engines (stove)
<b>14</b>	Agricultural and municipal waste conversion devices producing energy.
<b>15</b>	Equipment for utilising ocean waves and geo-thermal energy.
