**No.STA.2002/CR-24A/Taxation-2.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 41 of the Bombay Sales Tax Act, 1959 (Bom. LI of 1959), the Government of Maharashtra hereby, **with effect from the 1st May 2002**, amends, \*the Government Notification, Finance Department, No. STA. 1095/37/Taxation-2, dated the 22nd September 1995, being satisfied that it is necessary so to do in public interest, as follows :—

In the Schedule appended to the said notification, in Group A, after entry 150, the following entry shall be added, namely :-

<b>"151.</b> Sales or purchases made by a Registered dealer of Life Saving Drugs covered by entry 37 of Part II of Schedule C, being medicinal formulation or preparation ready for use internally or externally and specified in the Appendix given below, whether sold under a generic name or a brand name.
